Entry Form

This event is open to school teams and individuals.

The schedule for the event is below with times to be added once entries are in.

Saturday 17th February - Teams and individuals arrive at the hotel.

Sunday 18th February - Training on the hill with Coaches from Impulse Racing.

Monday 19th February - Training on the hill with Coaches from Impulse Racing.

Tuesday 20th February-Morning - Slalom race for U14's and above with a Kombi for U12's and below - We May look at a stubby slalom instead but this will depend on feedback.

Kombi promotes wider skill range at this age and is recommended by FIS.

GS race for all age groups/schools. Followed by a Parallel (head to head) event for school teams and individuals.

Tuesday 1st March - GS race for all age groups/schools. Followed by a Parallel (head to head) event for school teams and individuals.

The number of teams in each category will not be limited initially but this may need to be revisited should we become oversubscribed.

Please ensure that you let us know whether your team is from a Junior or Senior school.

All team members who complete at least one run in each event will be given an individual ranking for that event (fastest run will count for the results).

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The event is open to boys and girls in teams from the same school or individuals. Teams can be all boys, all girls, mixed or individual. Teams **DO NOT** need to comprise of children from the same age group, provided that the ages of the children are in line with those of the competition (this is to encourage team participation).

2. It is expected that all teams will be in the charge of a member of school staff or a parent with permission from the school. **If it is a parent, the entry form MUST be signed by the School**, giving authority to the parent concerned and for school absence.

3. Children must be attending the school they are representing during the Spring term 2016.

4. Competitors must be able to ski under control. Please do not bring children unless you are sure they are capable of riding a button lift and ski-ing the whole slope safely. The organisation reserve the right to limit entry to those they believe not to be skiing safely.

5. The age groups are: U8, U10, U12 U14, U16, U18 and U21.

6. Age of competitors are based on their Year of Birth (not school year) as we will be running with age groups as per the International Ski Federation - There is a clear Chart on age groups on the entry form.

7. As many skiers as you have from a school make up a team, and can be of mixed age group and gender. The best scoring 3 racers from your school will count toward the school team results.

8. Results will be determined as follows:

Schools - This will be done by achieving points per placing in age groups and awards will be given for 1st 2nd and 3rd teams in the following categories in both the junior and the senior schools categories.

Boys team, Girls team and Mixed team.

Points per age group	
1st place	10
2nd place	9
3rd place	8
4th place	7
5th place	6
6th place	5
7th place	4
8th place	3
9th place	2
10th place	1

The winning team will be the one that accrues the most points across the highest scoring three of the four members so only three need to finish one run.

The teams prizes will be awarded in three categories for boys team, girls team and mixed team irrespective of school gender.

Individuals - The fastest individual time of the two runs

9. Entries must be made on the enclosed form and signed by the member of staff or parental liaison responsible in the case of a school team or parent in the case of individual entries. Entries open on 14th of October 2017 and close on **Monday 12th of February 2018** (or before, if the race becomes oversubscribed). Names of skiers Can be submitted at anytime up to the of February 17th accompanied by **ALL** Paperwork including the entry form and the athletes/schools declaration forms. If we do not have all of these details by this date, it will jeopardise your teams entry. Team changes after this date will not be permitted without supporting medical evidence.

10. Entries not complying with the rules will not be accepted.

11. Any matter arising on the day which is not covered by these rules will be determined by the race jury, whose decision is final.

12. Further information will be sent by email via Mailchimp. It is essential that you ensure the email address you supply is accurate and clear and look out for these mails.

13. The entry fee will be £75 per person to cover all races at the event.

If you wish, you may send the entry form initially with no names but the names of skiers **MUST** be provided by the above closing date of February 17th.

14. Please indicate the name(s) of your race volunteer(s) on the entry form. It is a condition of entry that schools should provide one race volunteer per team entered. These volunteers will be required to complete simple tasks helping our coaches run the race.

15. It is a rule of the organisers that all racers must wear a ski helmet and that **no camera mounts are attached to the helmet.**
